NUST Centre for Counseling and Career Advisory (C³A)





The Counseling and Career Advisory provided by C³A is part of Student Services and offers a confidential, professional service to all members of the NUST community. People come to Counseling with a range of concerns varying from short term personal, social, family or academic worries to longer term, often more complex, psychological problems.

A Counselor's aim in C3A is to accept individual differences, listen empathetically and try to help individuals pursue their own understanding of what is to be done to lead a healthy and prosperous life. The Counseling Service provides a welcoming and friendly environment where a counselor seeks to help individuals focus and understand more clearly on the issues that concern or trouble them. The counselor's role is to offer support, understanding and respond in a non-judgmental and non-critical way. At C³A, we respect values, choices, lifestyle and help people explore their feelings and interests by guiding them in making decisions, choices or changes that are right for them.

CORE OBJECTIVES

- To provide a high quality professional counseling service to students who experience educational, social, emotional, personal, psychological or adjustment problems which inhibit academic performance and personal
- To continually review and evaluate practice and pursue new initiatives which address the changing needs of the University community.

TYPES OF ASSESSMENT OFFERED
